

The Sacramento River Westside Levee District is seeking bids for controlled grazing on approximately five linear miles of levee slope as outlined in the attached kmz map. The grazing area is broken into four sections, two in Yolo County and two in Colusa County with convenient county road or highway access to each site. The grazing shall be performed from North to South. The vegetation consists of grasses, broadleaf weeds, blackberry and other woody debris. The grazing is to be completed no later than September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 in preparation of the District's fall DWR levee inspections. Crude measurements of the grazing area are as follows:

Area 1 – Approximately 35 acres

Area 2 – Approximately 22 acres

Area 3 – Approximately 18 acres

Area 4 – Approximately 7 acres

Bids must include grazing for all areas. Bids should include a detailed description of plans for fencing and supervision of the herd. The award of the bid will be based on the lowest responsive bidder, meeting all of the District's specifications and conditions, subject to the right of the District to award the contract to a bidder which is not the lowest responsive bidder when the District determines it would be in the best interest of the District.

All bids must be delivered to Sacramento River West Side Levee District, 975 Wilson Bend Road, Grimes, CA 95950 by 5:00 p.m. March 29, 2023.
