B. YOLO BYPASS TOUR

9:00AM 1 Tour of Fremont Weir and Fish Passage

Meet at the corner of Rd 117 and Old River Road, just north of I-5 and next to the Sacramento River

10:30AM 2 Tour of Lower Elkhorn Setback Levee

Meet at County Road 124 approximately one-half mile southwest of Old River Road (see map)

Summary: The Lower Elkhorn Basin Levee Setback (LEBLS) Project is being constructed by California's Department of Water Resources. It is setting back the two miles of the north levee of the Sacramento Bypass and five miles of the east levee of the Yolo Bypass, within the Lower Elkhorn Basin. The project will improve flood flow conveyance of the bypass system. The project is nearing completion of construction, which is expected in 2024.

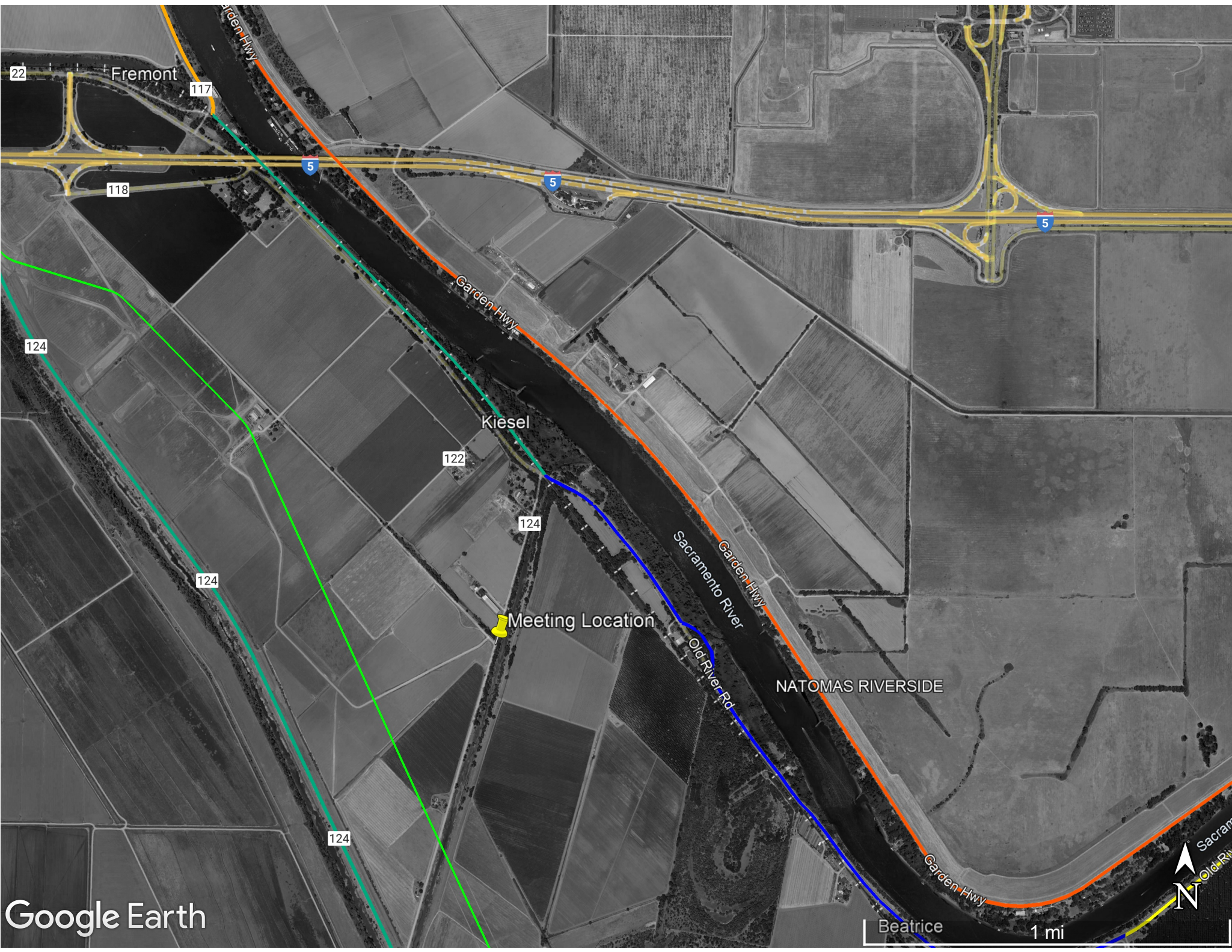
In addition to the LEBLS Project, the USACE is building an extension of the Sacramento Weir which will utilize the increased conveyance capacity of the Sacramento Bypass.

Associated with the LEBLS Project, ancillary projects include 1) construction of interior drainage system improvements made necessary by construction of the setback levees, 2) construction of a new pump station to replace three historic pump stations effectively abandoned by construction of the setback levee, and 3) relocation and remediation of an old burn dump that was in the way of the setback levee construction.
